



PROJECT HOMELESS CONNECT III – DECEMBER 6, 2006

RESULTS AND HIGHLIGHTS

- Mayor Chuck Reed and Chair of the County Board of Supervisors Don Gage kicked off the rally
- Over 500 unhoused families and individuals were assisted
- Over 30 agencies provided services and resources including medical exams and flu vaccinations, legal advice, housing information and applications, a holiday boutique, advocacy, haircuts, employment skills and job search assistance, wheel chair repair and many others
- City Team Ministries provided 600 boxed lunches for un-housed clients, volunteers and agency staff
- 150 people received haircuts from over 50 cosmetology students from Gavilan College
- 12 full dental visits were completed on-site
- Three staff mobile dental and medical clinics were onsite providing services to clients and veterans
- Applications were available onsite for 29 housing units so clients could apply for them
- 3 shuttles were busy transporting homeless clients from 3 shelters to and from Parkside Hall as well as doing outreach to unhoused residents in parks, under bridges, and river/creek sides
- 50 new cases were opened for County social services such as food stamps, medical, and general assistance
- 130 volunteers provided greeting and guiding services to un-housed clients
